Newman Theological College offers bursaries to new and continuing students enrolled in its programs and courses.

The **Catholic Teacher Education Bursary Fund** was established in 1998 by the Superintendents of East Central Alberta, Elk Island and St. Thomas School Divisions.

Eligibility: Applicants must be employed by one of the three sponsoring school districts on probationary or continuing contract and recommended by the principal of their school.

Value: Bursary covers 75% of the tuition cost of graduate level courses.
Bursary covers 100% of the tuition of Certificate in Catholic Studies courses.

Number of Bursaries: Multiple bursaries available.
