

FACULTY ADVISOR Form

The faculty advisor is a full or part-time instructor at Newman Theological College who has agreed to meet periodically with a student to offer advice on academic matters including:

- a) Selection of topics for research papers or a thesis
- b) Clarification of theological issues relating to course work, including required reading & books reviewed
- c) Course planning, considering the needs and interests of the student, the structure of the curriculum and the College timetable
- d) Field education requirements, alternatives and related course selections
- e) Preparing for comprehensive examinations and integrative seminars
- f) The methodology of research, including the effective use of library resources.

All full-time and those part-time students who are eligible to complete a degree or diploma in a given year are required to have a faculty advisor. Each student should approach the prospective advisor for acceptance, and then have him/her sign the form below. The form is to be submitted to the Registrar before September 30th, 2017. Students who have not chosen a faculty advisor by that date will be assigned one by the Registrar.
