

## **ATTEND SPICE FOR CREDIT!**

### Course Requirements:

- Pre-retreat reading (reading and detailed course outline will be sent after registration);
- Attendance at SPICE 2017 Retreat;
- Complete pre-Retreat reading(s) and submit a short 4-5 page reflection on the first day of the Retreat;
- Meet with the instructor during the Retreat to determine the topic and focus of a longer 15-20 page essay to be completed by early June; and
- Course registration and fees are additional costs paid to the respective college.
- Course registrations with the respective institution and ACSTA SPICE Registration must be completed by March 29.

Registration by this deadline is important, as the course will be cancelled if enrollment is insufficient.
